



## VEHICLE ATTACK RECOGNITION AND RESPONSE PROGRAM

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Vehicle Attack Recognition and Response Program consists of two days of intensive training. The first half of day one is dedicated to classroom presentations on driving in high-risk environments and vehicle and roadside bombs. The remainder of the program will be spent performing practical exercises that address a broad range of potential dangers one might encounter in moderate-to-high risk driving environments.

### CLASSROOM SUBJECTS

#### **Introduction to High-Risk Driving**

Participants will be introduced to the differences between driving in a low-to-moderate risk environment and a moderate-to-high risk environment.

#### **Threat Assessments**

No protective effort can get off to an efficient or effective start without first determining what threats exist to the protected subject. Through this presentation, participants will learn how to properly conduct a threat assessment on their vehicle operations.

#### **Armored Vehicles**

This presentation will review the strengths, weaknesses, operational myths, and operational realities of popular armored car packages, systems, and components.

#### **Advancing Review**

Participants will receive an in-depth review on how to properly conduct pre-operational protection detail advances on routes and static locations.

#### **Motorcade Operations**

Participants will learn how to properly design, choreograph, and conduct a multi-vehicle operation in both normal and emergency conditions.



### **Arrivals and Departures**

A great number of attacks on vehicle-borne targets occur as the subject moves from or to a waiting vehicle. Participants will learn how to properly choreograph and conduct arrivals and departures for single and multi-vehicle operations.

### **Roadside Bombs and IED's**

Roadside bombs and IED's are becoming an increasingly popular method by which modern-day terrorists and bandits commit assaults on vehicle operations. Participants will learn about the most common vehicle and roadside bombs and how to detect them.

## **PRACTICAL EXERCISES**

### **Roadside Bombs and IED's**

Participants will practice detecting mocked roadside and vehicle bombs.

### **Motorcade Operations**

Participants will practice negotiating emergency driving situations while traveling in multi-vehicle formations.

### **Motorcycle Attacks**

Participants will practice defeating motorcycle attacks that commence from the rear of a vehicle movement.

### **Arrivals and Departures**

Participants will practice safely transitioning a principal away from and to a waiting vehicle.

### **Firearms Deployment from a Static Vehicle**

Participants will practice mounting an effective armed defense from immobilized vehicles.

### **Unarmed Combative Techniques from a Static Vehicle**

Participants will practice unarmed combative techniques from an immobilized vehicle against single, multiple, armed, and unarmed assailants.
